Homeowners

- Must have income of 30%-60% of the Phoenix area median income range
- Must have at least a two-year history of stable income
- Must have a good credit record
- Must demonstrate the need for adequate housing
- Must complete 400 hours of sweat equity (300 on their home)
- Must attend classes in home maintenance, budgeting, debt management and credit and home ownership
- Must be a citizen of the United States or a permanent legal resident
- Must pay closing costs and carry an interest free mortgage on the home

Volunteers

- Give back to the community in sharing of their time, money and talents to those needing a hand up
- Meet in front of the Church at dawn one Saturday a month; carpool to the build site; receive instruction from the House Leader; pray with all of those on site; work throughout the day in small groups with the guidance of a Habitat Team Leader; enjoy a delicious lunch provided by fellow parishioners; clean up at the site mid-afternoon and return to the Church
- Give of their time in preparing and serving delicious meals to site volunteers
